

Attendance Policy



School attendance is taken at 8:30 a.m. Your child is late at 8:31 a.m.

Breakfast is served from 8:05 – 8:25 am. Walkers should arrive as close to 8:05 am as possible (especially if they are eating breakfast).

All students arriving after 8:31 am are considered late and **parents must sign them in at the office before going to class.**

All students being dropped off after 8:31 am must arrive through the main doors of the building. **Parents please walk your child into school and sign the late form.**

Students who attend school regularly have been shown to achieve at higher levels than students who do not have



	<p>18 OR MORE DAYS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Excused and unexcused absences represent lost time in the classroom and lost opportunities to learn. Missing just one day every two weeks can add up to 18 days in a year. Absences add up before you even know it.
	<p>10 TO 17 DAYS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students who are absent an average of 15 days a year miss a year's worth of school before their senior year. When students miss a day of school it actually puts them two days behind their classmates.
	<p>9 OR FEWER ABSENCES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students with good attendance generally achieve higher grades and enjoy school more. Children benefit and make the most of their educational opportunities if they attend school regularly and on time.
